Bagged residential and commercial garbage is accepted for the following fees:

The minimum fee covers loads up to 68 kilograms (approximately 150 lbs).

Flattened cardboard and boxboard is accepted for recycling at no charge.

Payment is accepted by Cash, Interact, Master Card, Visa or Prepaid Card.
